

### **TRCA Youth Council Program Framework**




# Current Membership Interests and Demographics - as of December 2023

#### **Current Membership**


- Youth is defined as 16-30 years old

- 505 current members
- 69% Female, 28 % Male, 3% Other

#### **Location of Members**



  - One NYGEP participant applied to Toronto CALLs Program





## Youth Council RWA Representative Plans 2024 Term
